Today we have with us Nodal Officer for UG Admission and Samarth Portal, Dr. Mahadev Gawas. Welcome yourself. So, admissions are around the corner and students and parents are worried, anxious about how the process is going to be.

00:30 Speaker : in various colleges of kawas so sir uh to me as uh with dhartha angdashas palakang through this video we will tell them what is exactly going to be the process uh this year

00:59 Speaker : their golden time of any students in their career. If you decide a career in that period, you will have a program course for enrollment. So that you have to take a decision. And you can do undergraduate programs like Bachelor of Arts, Bachelor of Commerce, Bachelor of Science, BSc Agriculture or those who want to do BSc B.A. or BSc BA or BALB or music.

01:28 Speaker : So all these programs which come under the Directorate of Higher Education, their admissions will start from the 27th of May from 11 a.m. also. So though the Burgyang candidates, the applicants, they anxiously wait after applying for programs, they have to visit this Directorate of Higher Education website and they have instructions for the Burgyang guidelines that the application will be done online. So last year already, new education policy

01:58 Speaker : has been implemented in the state of goa so how is it going to be different than the admission process which was there last year so last year was

the first year where almost across the goa undergraduate and general program especially NEP implementation so when Burgi admission will be also enrolling under the NEP implementation only

02:23 Speaker : In the last year, we had a paper selection in the last year and we had a specific general program like Bachelor of Arts, Bachelor of Commerce, Bachelor of Science and we had a scheme of disciplines like for example, single major or single minor, double major or single minor, multidisciplinary or interdisciplinary and we had a paper selection

02:47 Speaker : It is based on NEP, but it is stream-based for example Bachelor of Business Administration, Bachelor of Computer Applications or Bachelor of Vocational It is a paper selection for NEP So it is a specific program It is a specific and interdisciplinary and specialization If you have a Bachelor of Arts, Bachelor of Commerce, Bachelor of Science, then you have to learn that

03:15 Speaker : There will be options this time onwards in Sagra Colleges I have already been in Sagra Colleges in the administrative control and they have been approved for the UG program For example, single major and single minor in Bachelor of Arts Double major, single minor in Bachelor of Arts Similarly, same thing in Arts, Science and Commerce So, they have been able to do the same application So, if you apply for admission, it will be for across the

03:44 Speaker : programs for all the colleges under the administrative director of higher education will be held on a Samarth platform. Now this Samarth platform is built by the IIT Delhi and under the leadership they have executed this across the multiple states and Goa will be one of the states who will be implementing this Samarth platform for all the academic activities in the colleges who are under the administrative control of the director of higher education.

04:13 Speaker : So, Portalajer, first of all, he has to do the registration. I think the important thing is that this time onwards, unlike I mean, last year, conventionally follow-up. It's time to do Portalajer registration. Okay. It's time to do Portalajer registration, he will see all the programs, which are there in various colleges, which are under the administrative control of Director of Higher Education. So, that's it. They subsequently apply for programs.

04:41 Speaker : So previously, in the last 2-3 years we used to have a policy that we had to apply for three colleges So this time onwards, when we went to

Samarthan Portal, there was no preference for the first time Students can independently apply to any of the colleges Also, the Samarth platform, students can apply to any number of colleges and any number of programs

05:08 Speaker : He can apply in two or three different colleges or even four or five colleges. There is no limit for it. Similarly, one college has multiple programs, single major, double major. In that time, you can apply two applications independently in the same college for applying for a different program. But they have to apply separately. So in the process, just for information for our students.

05:38 Speaker : registration multiple times and during the first registration time itself you apply personal details, educational details and the educational documents you can upload thereafter once you apply for only first college of your choice you can apply to another college or program you can keep on applying without filling all these previous details of your personal details educational details or any upload documents

06:03 Speaker : That is a one-time exercise. You can keep on doing that multiple times. Will it depend on colleges or will it be through portal? Because it is an independent student will be applying without any preferences to the college Every college will prepare the maritalist independently And students will have a choice thereafter So the maritalist will be displayed after the course duration The announcement will be done on the DHC portal So it will be announced on the summer portal as well as on the respective colleges So students will have a choice

06:46 Speaker : if he is appearing in one or two or even three he will have a choice to go and report it to the college and confirm his admission but then there will be a fixed time for the students to decide and take a call on that so every college will have their own counselling sessions every college will have a own counselling so Burgyan apply Khoicha college is married Lista Khoicha programs after offer the college in visit Karun because there are a water to the subject and combinations are made then he can confirm his admissions so that I mean the subject that if he is not getting then he can just go to the any other college

07:21 Speaker : If someone has a first married list, then there will be a subsequent round for a married list, then a wait list will be filled with a wait list. So subsequently, the admissions will be made. Will there be any charges for this registration? Okay, very important that in the summer, whether you apply for one

college or multiple programs or past programs, all this process is free of charge. So there is no...

07:49 Speaker : fees the student have to pay while applying for an online application for a registration process on the Samad portal. They have to only pay the fees later in college. You have to pay the respective fees of that particular program to the respective college and then you can confirm the seats. Okay. And then there are courses like for example BALLB which requires an entrance exam. So what will be the approach of directorate with regard to BALLB?

08:21 Speaker : And the BLB is a program where for admission you need an entrance exam. Goa University has conducted a GCLAD exam to become eligible for application for a BLLB program. So if you have an exam, you will have a valid GCLAD score and a valid GCLAD rank. They will be eligible to apply for colleges.

08:51 Speaker : We are going to two colleges, one Sargavkar Law College and one Kare Law College. When the students apply to the BLLB program, if they apply to the summer portal, they apply to both colleges. Because the BLLB is a central counselling. And in central counselling, the students have opportunities based on the ranking.

09:18 Speaker : that he can opt for admission sometimes they apply for only one college and because they have not applied to other colleges they miss out on getting admission so it is mandatory for a student who is applying for a BALB that he has to apply for both the colleges on the summer portal Similarly, the B.A.B.A. is a program in two colleges, one is Vidya Prabhupada and one is a formal passager college. They have been counseling, so the admission is done through the counseling. They have an entrance exam that is purely based on the maritalist of the 12th standard marks. So because they are counseling, they have a B.A.B.A. If it is in the Vidya Prabhupada or a formal passager, they can apply to two colleges.

10:06 Speaker : during the time of the admission. So, if you apply for other colleges, they will not get it. So, it is mandatory for students only for this BALB and BABAD to opt and apply for both the colleges when they are applying for this program. So, this applies to both BABAD as well as those who want to pursue law, they have to apply in both the colleges. Sir, what changes were the first year admission?

10:37 Speaker : Last year, Burga had randomly made a major minor because it was an approval process regarding undergraduate programs, Bachelor of Arts, Bachelor of Commerce and Bachelor of Science. So after that, the college got notified. So this time, Burga got first year admission. There was an option to do single major and minor or double major and minor.

11:03 Speaker : It is a problem that people are confused if we have a single major and minor, then we have to change it, double major and minor, so what am I supposed to do? And then we have to change it, double major and single minor and then we have to change it in a period of time, single major and single minor, so what can I do? So this problem is that people have a program under NEP, arts, commerce, and science, but it is an exploratory year

11:33 Speaker : So he is taking two majors and two minors in the first year. So if you have admission time, just to give an example, we have a single major and minor in Bachelor of Arts with a single major as a history and a minor as a political science. Now he has to ensure that out of those four papers, the two major and two minors,

11:59 Speaker : he has to cover that one at least one paper as a history and one paper as a political science okay after he don't paper the history and political science get law because at the time of admission for a first year he decided that he wanted to go for a single major in history and minor as a political science but by the time he also studies the other two papers in those out of those four papers yeah suppose the english paper as a minor or major and say for example economics now at the time of the third semester

12:29 Speaker : in the second year yeah in fact he's eligible to change his program also from what he has chosen in the first year instead of having a history political science okay because then if economics he can switch it to the general one of those four four papers any papers he can take because the double major and the minor give up and if there is a program in any of the college or the same college where these four papers have a combination double major and minor he can still qualify but it will be only out of those four papers only preferably out of those four papers because that is how been uh it is currently accommodated in the goa industry structure yeah uh and are there

13:08 Speaker : going to be any changes in the second year admissions now

since they are so last year I mean before that also he first batch NEP last year NEP admission actually they'll be going for a second year admission and this is very important information for those students who will be seeking their admission in the second year at the second year they must have studied some four papers under major minor major minor in the first semester and second semester yeah now they have to

13:35 Speaker : figured out that we have to learn 4 papers in any of the colleges. And they have to find out what is their choice of interest and what are the programs approved in their respective colleges. If you have 4 papers, maybe there is just one program in that college which offers that major and minor. But there might be colleges where there are multiple choices out of those 4 papers. Or maybe he can choose to have that program in some other college also. He can switch it to the other college also if he is qualifying with those 4 papers to opt for any other single major or double major.

14:04 Speaker : We don't have colleges at the same time. We don't have single major, single minor, double major and single minor program. We don't have multidisciplinary and interdisciplinary. So we don't have that option based on the four papers that we study. We don't have a choice if we have a single major or a minor or a double major.

14:32 Speaker : Many times they take advantage of a double major for example for Hindi and Kokuni So a double major means 60-40 So first paper is of the 60% and second paper is of the 40% But a double major means he is qualified to

15:00 Speaker : because both are major papers he is qualified to answer his net papers in any of the subjects out of the school even for his masters also he is qualified for that so that's a big advantage that is the advantage for a student to go with that particular level for a double major but it is up to the student's choice to make whether it is a single major they want to study or whether they want to study for a double major but one scheme defines a league

15:22 Speaker : in the third semester whether I'm going for a single major and minor or a double major minor thereafter the students cannot change then they can't change so there is a realization that unlike the CBCS now you cannot change it after the third semester that can be predefined So, if you register for the program, you can apply major and minor as well as a subject or maybe double

major minor. That you will continue throughout till your third year, three year program. So, actually second year they are deciding. Exactly, second year they are deciding. More importantly because those two papers anyway you have to study in the first year also. So, it is all as good as you are starting from the first year that you have predefined. Only thing is that you have an option when you are studying at two different more papers.

16:06 Speaker : Later, after maybe after a few years, once the multidisciplinary or interdisciplinary programs are approved, then the students will have a plethora of options to opt for it. So how many credits exactly they will have to complete for the course? Now under NEP, they will have a flexibility to do for a four-year program. So they will have a major paper, 60 credits.

16:34 Speaker : Minimum. Minimum. And it is a four years as well, it comes to 80. The four-year program is either through the research or through the honors program, through the papers, by papers. So that 12 credits extra, so it becomes a 92, four years as well. The minor papers as well, so if that minor paper has to qualify for students to come and print in the certificate, then the minimum 12 credits of that particular one single subject, student has to study.

17:02 Speaker : So that I suppose history and political sciences, the political sciences at least minimum 12 credits can be studied to appear as a history, as a major and political science as a minor subject. Sir, the first round of admission is very good. They are not aware. So, will there be another round for... See, here 40 questions, because every college will prepare the merit list independently.

17:26 Speaker : Quite chances are that the higher percent might appear in the multiple colleges' merit list first. And those who are with the lower percentage might not appear in the first case of the merit list. So subsequently, Kasha, students have one place in college at the time of admission. So subsequently, there will be vacancies, the wait list will be called thereafter. So students need not have to panic in the very first day when the merit list is paid.

17:50 Speaker : I need to get a waitlist, I need to apply three colleges and I need to get married list and subsequently over the due period of time within three days or four days as the admission counselling round starts because that is going to be real time this time so that will be automatically reflected in real time on the summer portal for other colleges and then subsequently there will be vacancies

and then other students will be those who are in the waitlist will be called for a counselling so students need not panic on the very first day when they see the married list

18:18 Speaker : that their names are not appearing and it is only appearing in the waitlist. And if there are two or three colleges, then unfortunately the three will be applied. There will be subsequent second round also where the students can change, apply in the different colleges and take the chances for new programs of their choices. Okay. 18:47 Speaker : No, I would preferably say that the students have to smartly and wisely choose that and more importantly, while choosing the career, the programs. rather than more on the from the influence by their friends or by their parents they have to find out what is their interest in so then they would love to study those particular programs over the period of three years or four years or maybe they can take up up to the for a high studies for the for the phd as well for a doctorate program so if the student is studying the subjects of their interest then it's very likely that the students will take on that particular studies more seriously and then they will likely to go up to the higher studies
