O R D E R

SUBJECT: Revision of Pattern of Assistance to
Goa University.

The question of laying down the revised Pattern of Assistance for release of grants to Goa University was under consideration of Government. The Government is now pleased to issue revised consolidated instructions regarding the revised pattern of assistance for releasing grants to Goa University as follows:

1. The authority receiving the grants such as Goa University for teaching and non-teaching staff shall be required to obtain prior approval of the State Government before any incumbent is appointed to such posts.
2. The age of retirement on superannuation of every employee covered by this pattern of assistance including the Teaching staff, Academic staff as well as Non-teaching staff excluding Group 'D' staff of the Goa University shall be 58 years. The grant will be admissible or payable in respect of any employee as mentioned above in the event he/she is continuing, re-appointed or appointed on contract without prior Government approval. The State Government shall not bear any expenditure which is incurred on any employee/employees who are employed or continued to be employed in violation of any of the clauses of this order. Such of those employees who ever the Goa Government desires to give extension of services, re-employment, re-appoint on contract basis, prior approval of the Government should be obtained and only in cases where the State Government has approved such re-appointment/contract, continuation of re-employment such employees shall be eligible for grant during the period covered by such approval. Also to pay fixation/protection due to revision/promotion.

3. Whenever, the Goa University authority send the proposal for granting extension of services to any employee, re-employed, re-appointment or appointment on contract basis, the State Government may grant such approval only in exceptional cases duly justified by reasons to be recorded in writing.
4. The State Government shall be entitled to recover, by withholding, any part of the grant or adjustment toward admissible expenditure or any part of grant including maintenance grant in the event it is discovered that an extension of services, re-employed, re-appointed or appointed on contract basis is in violation of any clauses of this order and such recovery may be made out of the grants for the subsequent financial year or years although the payment might have been made in the preceding financial year or years.
5. The Goa University shall abide by any such instruction for recovery. Provided the State Government shall first issue show cause notice and seek an explanation from the concerned authorities before any order for recovery is made against the concerned University within such time prescribed by State Government.
6. The Goa University shall be bound to submit such information and to furnish such documents as are required of it by the State Government either through itself or through Directorate of Higher Education. In the event of any non-compliance on the part of Goa University, State Government shall be entitled to forthwith withhold/stop the coverage and entitlement of Goa University for re-appointment contract continuation or re-employment for any grant under this order.

7. Block grants for 5 years beginning from 2002-03 are fixed as shown hereunder:

a) Non-Plan Grants:

The Block grant fixed above include 6% increase every year on Non-Plan grant assessed on the basis of grant fixed during 2001-2002.

The balance of grants released upto now and as fixed above would be adjusted in future grants.

b) The plan programmes of the Goa University shall be approved by Planning Commission on the basis of which allocations are provided in "State Annual Plan" keeping in view availability of resources. Prior approval of the State Government should be obtained for plan allocation of any new project being initiated by the Goa University. The University would be entitled to assistance against its plan expenditure to the extent of allocation made in the State Plan.


8. The receipts realised by the Goa University have not been taken into account while fixing the above block grant under Non-Plan.

9. The above pattern is subject to review during 2007-2008.

10. The University shall comply with the other conditions prescribed in G.F.R.
