1. INTRODUCTION

Prologue

This prospectus has been prepared by the Directorate of Higher Education (DHE), Government of Goa, for admission to the B.Ed. Degree Programme in the State of Goa.

This prospectus has been divided into two parts. The first part is primarily concerned with the process of admission (number of seats, rules of admission, criteria for eligibility, etc). The second part pertains to the information on the B.Ed. Colleges in the State of Goa and Proforma for Certificates.



graduation level. The second subject will be allotted by the Institutions. In case adequate number of applicants are not available for any one particular subject the seat shall be transferred to another subject.

- 2. If the number of applicants belonging to the reserved categories is inadequate in a particular subject, the said seats will be transferred to the general category in that particular subject. However, this will not be applicable for EWS category.
- 3. If documentary evidence including all/any certificate is not produced at the time of Interview, the candidate's eligibility will be rejected.
- 4. The reservations of seats are on rotation basis and will change from year to year.
- 5. The seat matrix revision is based on demand and modified as per the decision of the concerned college, duly approved in the relevant meeting.

2. RULES OF ADMISSION

- 3.1 All notifications related to admission shall be notified on DHE website.
- 3.2 The application form must be filled in by the applicant and submitted by him/her online.
- 3.3 The last date for receiving applications online shall be as mentioned in the schedule of the admission process. Any request for granting extension of time for submission of forms or admission at a later date, shall not be entertained under any circumstances.
- 3.4 The Applicant claiming a seat in the reserved category of SC/ST/OBC is required to submit the caste certificate in the prescribed proforma given in Annexure II & III from the competent authority at the time of Counselling*. If the required certificate is not produced, his/her application will be treated as an application for the general category provided the applicant fulfils academic conditions of the general category.
- 3.5 No personal communication will be sent to the applicants. In the event of any change in the schedule of admission, the same will also be on DHE website.
- 3.6 The merit list shall be displayed as per the specified schedule on DHE website.
- 3.7 The academic eligibility shall be based on the rank obtained in the qualifying examination GU-ART and 4.2.
- 3.8 Admission shall be strictly based on Merit as per the rank obtained in the qualifying GU-ART.
- 3.9 All the applicants who are offered admission shall have to pay the requisite fees on the date of Counselling specified in the schedule.
- 3.10 Inviting applications according to this prospectus does not confer any right/claim to the applicant, for admission to the programme in a B.Ed. College.
- 3.11 Every eligible applicant who is desirous of seeking admission shall remain present as per schedule for the Counselling session along with the proof of identity and original documents.
- 3.12 If any of the seats fall vacant within one month of the commencement of the course, the same will be filled by the candidates on the waiting list/ merit list in the respective subjects.
- 3.13 The decision of the Admission Committee will be final in interpreting the rules of admission.
- 3.14 Applicants, who have passed the qualifying examination from Universities other than Goa University, shall be required to produce a Provisional Eligibility Certificate from the Goa University, within one week after securing admission to the Institutions, without which the admission shall not be confirmed.
- 3.15 Applicants/Parents/Guardians shall not canvass in any form to get an undue advantage. Such action may lead to rejection of the application form or right of admission to the applicant.

* In case there is less than required number of qualified candidates for Mathematics then said seats shall be allotted to candidates from the merit list of Physics subject and as per reservation policy outlined above. Decision of the admission committee will be final.

** Applicants seeking admissions for ICTE should have Graduation in any of the following- Computer Science (B.Sc.), Computer Application (BCA), Electronics (B.Sc). & Bachelor's in Engineering or Technology.

*** Applicants seeking admissions for Geography should have graduation/post graduation in Geography/Geology/Applied Geology.

+ Applicants seeking admissions for Physics should have graduation/post graduation in Physics/Electronics.

3.17 LIST OF HIGHER SECONDARY SCHOOL SUBJECTS / SUBJECT PEDAGOGIES offered for the B.Ed. Programme at PES's College of Education

1. COMMERCE (Post Graduates only)
2. SOCIAL SCIENCES (Post Graduates in Political Science / Economics / Sociology / Psychology only)

3.18 In case of a tie, due to applicants having the same rank at the GU-ART, the seat will be allotted to candidates in the following manner

- a) Candidate having PG Degree in the relevant subject.
- b) If both candidates possess PG Degree in the relevant subject, then it will be allotted to a candidate having a higher percentage.
- c) If either of the candidates doesn't possess a PG degree in the relevant subject, then the seat will be allotted as follows:
 - i) Seat will be allotted to the candidate having majored in the relevant subject at the third year with six units.
 - ii) If both candidates have six units at the T.Y. level in the relevant* subject, then it will be allotted to a candidate having a higher percentage.

* relevant subject implies as specified under 3.16 and 3.17 respectively.

d) In instances where everything remains same for either of the candidates as specified above at (a), (b), and (c) i and ii, then the seat will be allotted to the candidate who is senior in age.

4. ELIGIBILITY

- 4.1 The applicant shall be a citizen of India.
- 5.2 A candidate for the Bachelor of Education Programme must have passed a Bachelor/Post Graduate Degree Examination of Goa University or an equivalent degree from any other statutory University recognized as equivalent thereto, with a minimum of 50% marks (5% relaxation is given to candidates from the SC/ST/OBC categories) and/or in the Master's Degree in Sciences/Social Sciences/Humanity/Commerce, Bachelor's in Engineering or Technology with specialization in Science and Mathematics with 55% marks or any other qualifications equivalent thereto are eligible for admission to the programme . Further, the candidates should have taken at least one of the school subjects at his graduation/post graduation for which training is offered in the institution.
- 5.3 The applicant shall have answered Goa University Admission Ranking Test (GU-ART) 2026.

5. CLASSIFICATION OF CATEGORIES

5.1. Category 1: - General

An applicant belonging to General Category must satisfy one of the conditions as stated below:

- 9/c
- i. The Applicant must have passed the Bachelor/Post Graduate Degree Examination of Goa University or any other University and must have resided in Goa for a minimum period of 10 years (5 years for those whose either of the parents/ grandparents is/are born in Goa).
 - ii. Children of Government of Goa deputationists and employees posted outside Goa will be eligible for admission to the B.Ed. degree programme provided they have passed the qualifying examination from any University recognized by UGC.
 - iii. Any candidate who has obtained Graduate / Post Graduate Degree with a minimum of 50% from Goa University or from any other statutory body recognized by University Grants Commission is eligible for admission for B.Ed. Degree Programme. Further, candidates must have at Graduation / Post graduation at least one subject that is taught at school / higher secondary level and provided that such subjects are available as subject pedagogies in the institution in which the candidate seeks admission.

RELAXATIONS IN RESIDENTIAL REQUIREMENTS for Category 1 to 6 & 8

- iv. Provided further that any period spent by the applicant outside Goa on account of posting/leave/training/deputation of either of his/her parents being the Goa State Government Employee shall be counted towards the residence of 10 years (5 years for those whose either of the parents/grand-parents is/are born in Goa).
- v. Provided further that the period spent by the applicant in another State, under the scheme of Exchange Programme as a student of Navodaya Vidyalaya from Goa, shall be counted towards 10 years residence in Goa (5 years for those whose either of the parents/grandparents is/are born in Goa).

5.2. Category 2: - SC

Reserved for Scheduled Castes of Goa (2 %)

Castes: 1. Bhangui, 2. Chambhar (Hadi), 3. Mahar, 4. Mahyavanshi (Vankar) 5. Mang

Applicants belonging to the above castes included in the list of scheduled castes in the State of Goa shall be eligible in this category, on production of the caste certificate provided that

- a) He/She or his/her forefathers either belong to Goa or have migrated to Goa before 16th February 1968. (Non-migrant, Refer footnote¹).
- b) He/She meets all other conditions of the General category.

NB: **Migrant Schedule Caste / Schedule Tribe:** By Presidential Order dated 19th February 1968, the area comprising the Union Territory of Goa was recognised as State of Goa under the Goa, Daman and Diu Re-Organisation Act, 1987. Any person or his/her forefathers, who have migrated to Goa after the issue of the Presidential Order dated 19th February 1968, shall not be entitled to any benefit of reservation as Schedule Caste/Schedule-Tribe for admission to the Professional Colleges in Goa, even if their caste is specified as Schedule Caste/Schedule Tribe in relation to the State of Goa.

5.3. Category 3: - ST

Reserved for Scheduled Tribes of Goa (12%)

1. Dhodia (Halpati), 2 Dubla (Naikda /Nayaka), 4. Siddi, 5. Varli , 6.Kunbi, 7. Gawda, 8. Velip

An applicant belonging to the above tribes included in the list of scheduled Tribes in the State of Goa (Notification No. 13/14/90-SWD(Vol.II) dated 22-04-2003) shall be eligible in this category, on production of caste certificate provided that

- a) He/She or his/her forefathers either belong to Goa or have migrated to Goa before 16th February 1968. (Non-migrants, Refer footnote 1 above)
- b) He/she meets all other conditions of the General category.

The applicant belonging to the above communities included in the list of Other Backward Communities in the State of Goa shall be eligible for this category, on production of a valid certificate provided that

- He /She belongs to the **non-creamy layer** of OBC community as defined by the State/Central Government.
- He/She meets all other conditions of the General Category.

Certificate bearing **incorrect spelling** of the Caste name will not be accepted.

5.5. Category 5: PH

Reserved for Persons with benchmark disabilities

- As per Addendum issued by the Directorate of Higher Education vide no. 13/DHE/TL&ET/ADMSN/2023-2024/4225 dated 17/08/2023 All Government institutions of higher education and other higher education institutions receiving aid from the Government shall reserve not less than five percent seats for persons with benchmark disabilities.
- The persons with benchmark disabilities shall be given an upper age relaxation of five years for admission in institutions of higher education.

Seats are reserved for persons with disabilities as per the provision of Section 39 in the Act 1995 known as "The persons with disabilities (Equal opportunities, protection of Rights and full Participation Act 1995, Central Act 1 of 1996)". Persons suffering from not less than **40% (forty percent)** disability shall be eligible for the reserved seats.

The applicant claiming the seat under this category shall have to produce a certificate from the Medical Board of Goa Medical College regarding his/her disability and ability/fitness to undergo all components of the programme, such as theory, practicals, workshops etc. The percentage of disability should be recorded on the fitness certificate (vide Government of Goa notification No.13/140/87-PHD dated 20/7/88 to determine the extent of disability). The Admission Committee reserves the right to refer the case to Medical Board of Goa Medical College Hospital, Bambolim, in case of dispute/doubt.

5.6 Category 6: FF

Reserved for Children of Freedom Fighters (1%)

The Children of Registered Freedom Fighters from Goa shall be eligible under this category provided they meet all other conditions of the General Category.

5.7 Category 7: CSP

Reserved for children of Central and Defence Personnel & Para-military Forces, State Government and Public/Private Sector Employees and other persons having occupation/employment in Goa (1%)

Applicants who do not meet the residential requirement of general category and whose either of the parents belong to one of the following sub-categories shall be eligible for seats reserved under

this category, provided that the applicants belonging to sub-category (c) below should have studied and passed the Graduation/Post Graduation examination from Universities/Colleges in the State of Goa.

- a) Employees of Central Government and Central Government Public Sector Undertakings, including Defence and Para-Military personnel, transferred to and serving in the State of Goa in the month of Submission of the application form.
- b) Employees of Goa State Government including employees of Goa State Government public sector undertakings but excluding the employees on daily wages/NMR/Work Charged.
- c) Persons residing in the State of Goa for the purpose of occupation/employment for a minimum continuous period of 5 years immediately preceding the month of submission of application form.

The applicants who satisfy the eligibility criteria of General Category **will not be** considered under this (7) category.

5.8 Category 8:-ESM

Reserved for Children of Ex-Servicemen (1%)

The children of Ex-Defence Service Personnel, Ex-Para-Military Force Personnel (including those permanently disabled or killed in action), registered in the State of Goa and have studied and passed Graduate/Post Graduate examinations from Colleges/Universities in the State of Goa shall be eligible for the seat reserved under this category. Those applicants of this category who satisfy the eligibility criteria of General Category will be eligible for both the categories.

5.9 Category 9:-GN

Reserved for children of Natives of Goa (2%)

An applicant whose either of the parent / grandparent is born in Goa shall be eligible for seats reserved under this category, provided he/she does not fulfil the residence criteria of General category. Candidates fulfilling general category criteria shall not be considered under this category.

5.10 Category 10:-MINO

50% of the total number of seats in Nirmala Institute of Education, Panaji shall be reserved to the applicants belonging to Christian Minority in view of the minority status of the College. A Baptism Certificate from the Competent Authority should be attached. Those applicants of this category who satisfy the eligibility criteria of the General Category will be eligible for both the categories.

5.11 Category 11:- EWS

Reserved for Economically Weaker Sections of Goa:- (10%)

All eligible candidates from General Category Merit List shall be considered eligible for availing seats under Economically Weaker Sections Scheme, provided they submit EWS Certificate from a competent authority with their application Form.

6. CERTIFICATES AND TESTIMONIALS

Attested photocopies along with the original certificates should be produced at the time of Admissions/Counselling.

Essentials for all applicants

6.1 Statement of marks of Graduation/Post Graduation or its equivalent examination.

6.2 Birth Certificate from Competent Authority.

- 6.3 Certificate of residence: In order to establish residence eligibility the applicant is required to attach previous school certificates where he/she studied in Goa continuously for a period of 10 years. In case there is any break in study he/she is required to produce residence certificate from the Mamlatdar of the break period.
 - 6.4 One recent passport size photograph affixed on the application form.
 - 6.5 Applicants claiming seats reserved for SC/ST category should produce **Non Migrant Caste Certificate** in the prescribed pro-forma (Annexure II) from the Dy. Collector of the area concerned. Certificates issued by Village Panchayat/Mamlatdar shall not be accepted.
 - 6.6 An applicant claiming seats reserved for OBC category should produce Caste Certificate (non-creamy layer) in the prescribed pro-forma (Annexure III) from the Dy. Collector of the area concerned. Certificates issued by Village Panchayat/Mamlatdar shall not be accepted.
 - 6.7 An applicant claiming seats reserved for children of Freedom Fighters of Goa is required to produce a certificate in the prescribed pro-forma from the Home Department (Secretariat, Goa) that either of his/her parents is registered as a Freedom Fighter of Goa indicating the date and registration number.
 - 6.8 An applicant claiming seat reserved for the children of Goa State/Central Government Employees including Goa State/Central Government/Public Sector Undertaking and Defence Personnel (**Category 7 a & b**) will be required to produce the till date Service Certificate of the parent from the Head of Office/Department about posting of the parent. The Service Certificate should indicate the full name of the parent, designation, date of transfer order, date of joining and present status of posting.
 - 6.9 An applicant claiming seats reserved for children of persons staying in Goa for purpose of occupation (**Category 7 c**) shall be required to produce a certificate of his/her parent from the employer in case of service or certificate of establishment in case of self employment, indicating the date and period of employment.
 - 6.10 An applicant claiming the seat reserved for the children of Ex-service men shall be required to produce a certificate from the Secretary, Rajya Sainik Board indicating the full name and date and Registration number of ex-serviceman.
 - 6.11 An applicant claiming seats reserved for the children of Goan Natives (**Category 9**) shall produce a certificate of nativity, (either by birth or by domicile in Goa), either of parents/grandparents from the competent authority, with the certificate that the applicant has passed the qualifying examination from the schools/colleges located outside Goa, but within India.

7. ADMISSION PROCEDURE


Only those applicants who have applied in response to the prospectus of 2026-2028 and submitted their applications duly completed in all respects online on or before the last date and time and satisfy the eligibility criteria will be considered for admission to the B.Ed. programme strictly in order of merit.

7.1 PROCEDURE

- (i) The Admission procedure shall be online.
- (ii) The Counselling schedule will be displayed on DHE website.
- (iii) The Counselling process will be conducted OFFLINE at the DHE. Kindly note that on the day scheduled for General Category Counselling, candidates of ALL Categories are required to be present.
- (iv) The provisional and final merit lists will be displayed on the DHE website.
- (v) The Chairperson of the Admission Committee reserves the right to modify the schedule of admission, if required.
- (vi) Rules regarding cancellation of fees and refunds thereafter shall be governed as per the Goa University directives to the Colleges.


