The Directorate of Higher Education, Goa, has published the **Provisional Merit** List for B.Ed. Admissions 2026–28. Candidates are advised to carefully verify their details in the merit list.

In case of any discrepancy, grievance, or requirement to submit supporting/valid documents, candidates must report in person to the Directorate of Higher Education, Alto Porvorim, Goa, within the stipulated grievance period. No representations received after the prescribed deadline shall be entertained.

The final Merit List shall be displayed on **12th June 2026**.

Candidates are advised to regularly visit the DHE Goa official portal for updates and announcements.

Candidates must bring **originals** along with **one set of self-attested photocopies** of the following documents during the admission Counselling:

1. Graduation Degree Marksheet(s) and Certificate

If completed postgraduation, submit PG marksheets and certificate as well.

2. Migration Certificate (if applicable)
3. Transfer Certificate / Leaving Certificate
4. Caste Certificate (if claiming reservation under SC/ST/OBC) (Valid)
5. Income Certificate (if applying under EWS or for fee concession)
6. Domicile Certificate / Residence Proof (Valid)
7. Disability Certificate (if applicable)

**Note:**

1. Physical presence of the candidate at the admission counselling is mandatory for confirmation of admission to the college.
2. Candidates are required to complete the fee payment through online mode during the counselling session to confirm their seat.
